

Crossroads CID Sales Tax Election



Supporting our CID:

The Crossroads Community Improvement District has officially been established, with a mission to keep our neighborhood **clean, green, and safe**.

The CID will be supported by property tax assessments that have already been approved, as well as a **proposed 1/2-cent sales tax**, paid primarily by visitors to the Crossroads.



This 1/2-cent sales tax must be approved by voters within the district.
This is a mail-in election – no in-person voting is required.

How to Vote:

- If you're a registered voter, a ballot will be mailed to your address.
- The ballot must be completed, notarized, and returned in the provided envelope. Ballots must be received by 5 p.m. on December 2, 2025.
- The ballot must be notarized. You can have your ballot notarized at your bank or for free at Mazuma Credit Union in the Crossroads.



Why It Matters:

If approved, the sales tax will add **only 50¢ to a \$100 dinner bill**. This model ensures that everyone who enjoys the Crossroads helps support its upkeep. This modest contribution – **paid primarily by visitors and patrons** – will help:

- ⊕ **Keep our streets clean and well-maintained**
- ⊕ **Ensure green spaces and beautification projects thrive**
- ⊕ **Fund safety patrols and ambassador services**
